Hi family and friends,

First I want to thank all of you for your prayers and support. Since the CCSVI treatment I am a new man. The improvements in my MS symptoms have been, in my opinion, quite dramatic. My muscle spasticity, tingling in arms and legs, headaches, brain fog, fatigue and difficulty concentrating have all disappeared in the 3 ½ weeks since my procedure (also known as the liberation treatment). While in the recovery room both Andrea and my Mom saw colour in my face that they haven't seen in a very long time. There is one symptom that remains but with a dramatic reduction and that is pain in my psos and back muscles. I have stopped taking heavy painkillers and muscle relaxants and find that contrary to pre-treatment, physiotherapy seems to be working.

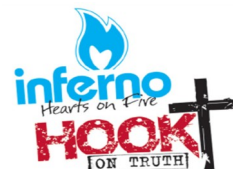
Most people don't know that had I not had this treatment, I believe I would have had to stop working by Christmas. Based on my current progression, I should be fully active (even running) again by Christmas.

The past 7 weeks of my life have been life changing. I took a step of faith and booked October 12th for the treatment knowing that the costs of the treatment would be too overwhelming for my family to sustain (\$15,000.00). I trusted God to meet this need. Andrea and I spoke of this to a few friends and without hesitation they began notifying their friend and co-workers of our need. We held a silent auction that raised \$4700.00 and the rest came in donations. In total we were supplied with just over \$15,000.00. We were constantly overwhelmed by the generosity of folks and God's provision. One week before our departure, the cost of the procedure was reduced by \$1000.00 and the hotel was covered for us by the clinic. All said and done we have a large surplus. We understand that this is not our money. We are paying all of it forward to another need.

Once again, we thank each of you for caring, supporting, praying and thoughts and we each of you are blessed for your kindness and generosity.
